## Agenda Action

The Blanchard City Council and the Board of Trustees of the Blanchard Municipal Improvement Authority discussed, considered and took appropriate action on the following agenda items at their regular February 27<sup>th</sup> meeting:

- ◆ Presentation was made by Deanna Mason re: Lead Me Home Program for individuals with disabilities;
- ◆ Awarded bid to Jordan Contractors in the amount of \$355,910 for sanitary sewer improvements to old town;
- ◆ Designated 55<sup>th</sup> Street as a 'No thru Truck Traffic'; removed South Tyler Avenue as an Alternate Truck route; and authorized City staff to prepare an ordinance pertaining to Limited Access Facilities for streets and roads;

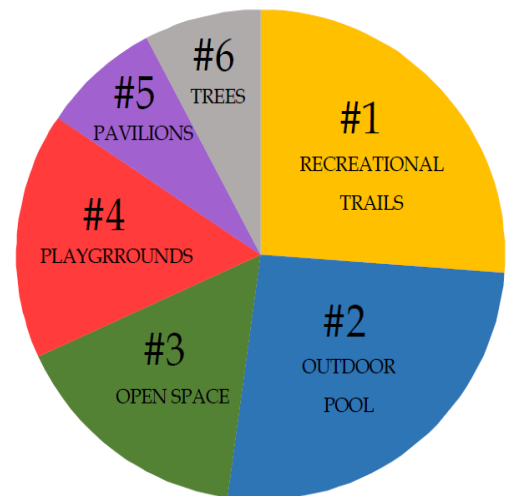
## Park Survey
