BACKGROUND:

Attached is a Survey of seven (7) metro OKC cities comparing their average of water and sewer rates with Blanchard. And a survey of other charges and fees compared to Blanchard.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Blanchard is below the 95%, 90% and 85% averages of water and sewer rates. Our water rates are lower than the 80% average and the sewer rates are 21.61% higher than the 80% average.

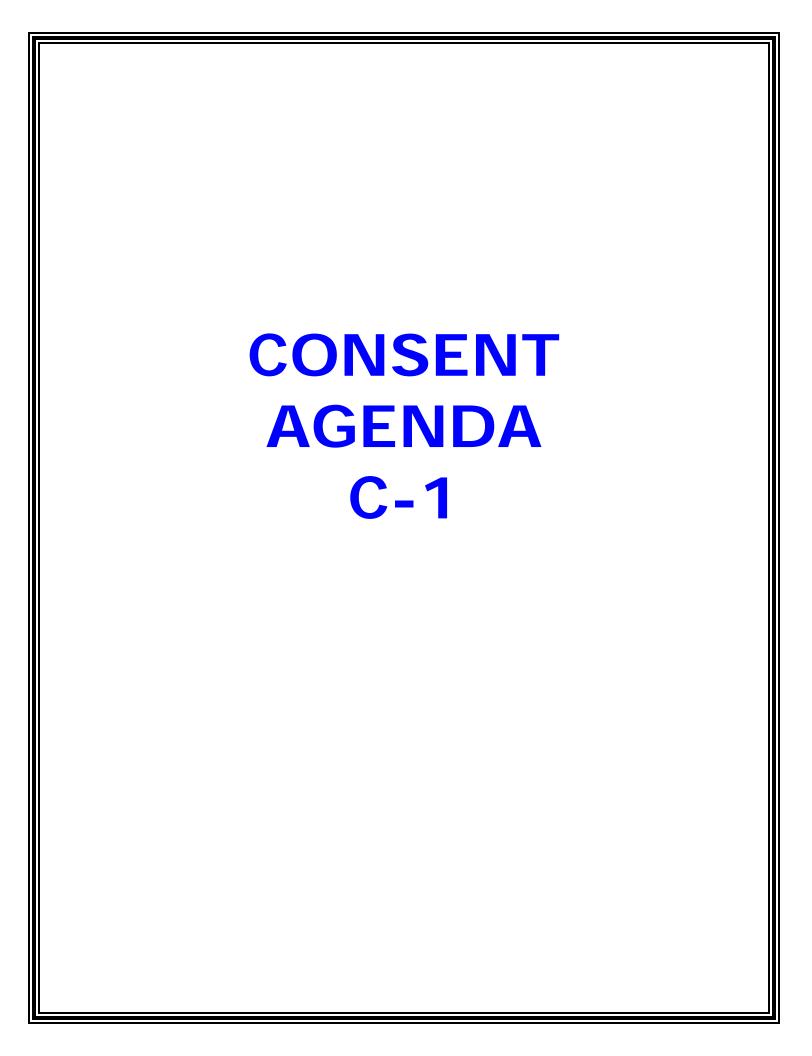

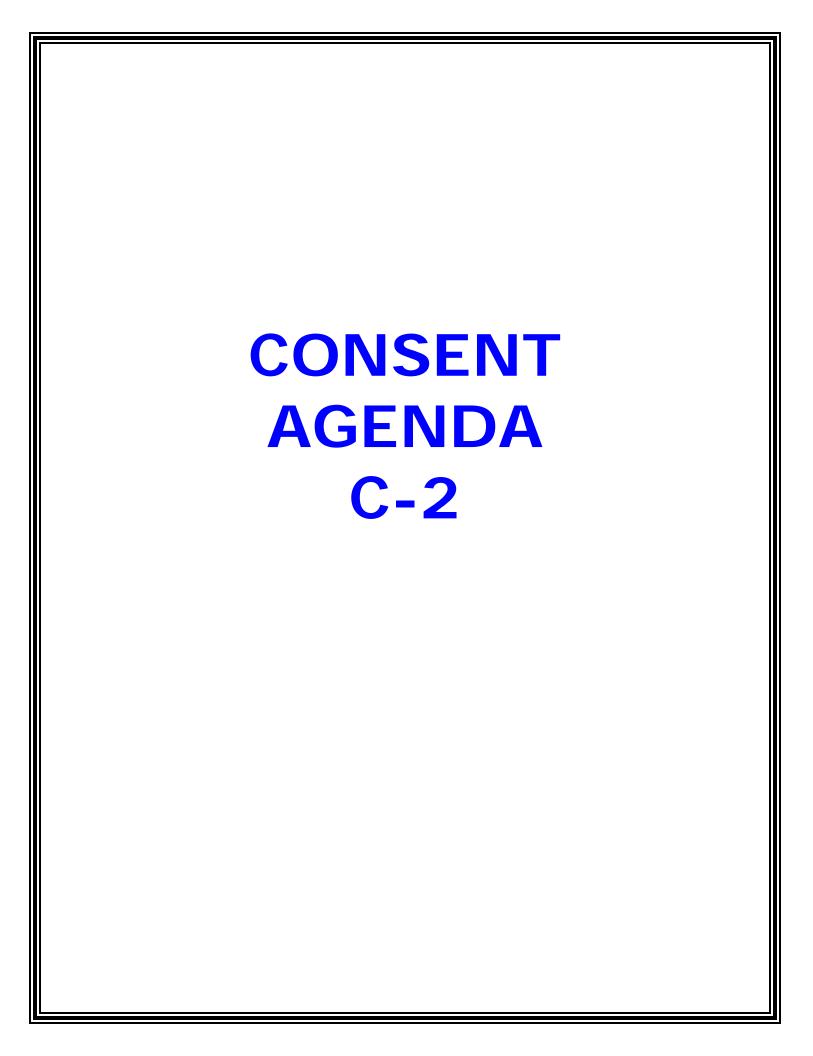
