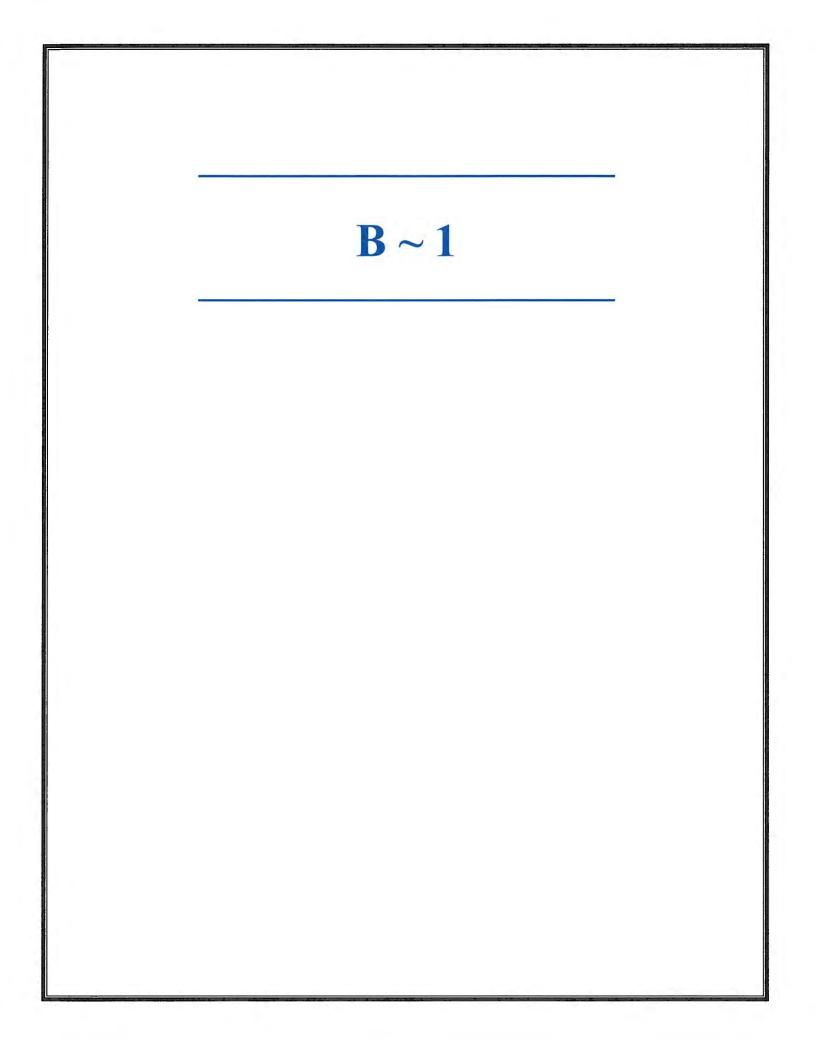

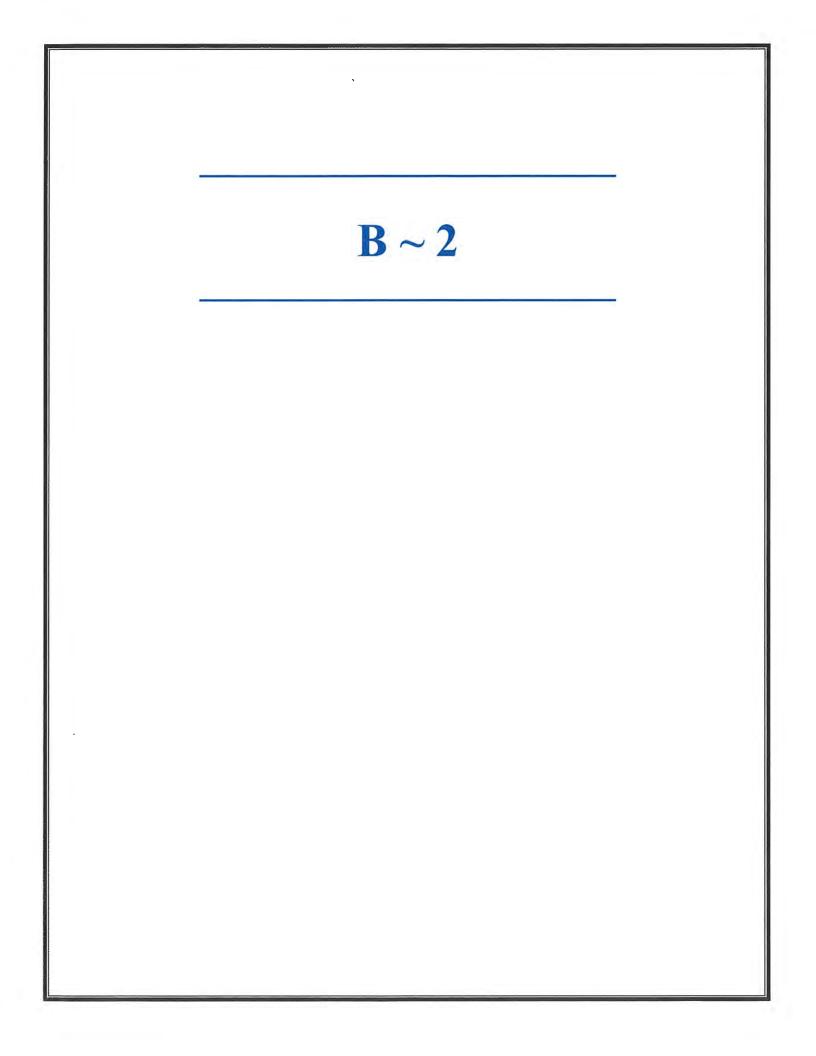
## Robert,

As you have seen, staff compiled water consumption numbers since January 2022, for everything fed off of the 8-inch line on Rockwell, south of US 62. This area includes Dibble and Cole. A summary of these findings is as follows:

Number of Meters	321 (01/2022) - 343 (07/2023)
Minimum Water Purchased in a Month	76,900 gpd
Maximum Water Purchased in a Month	252,900 gpd
Average Water Purchased in a Month	131,800 gpd

I recommend that we complete the process of contracting with Newcastle for up to 300,000 gpd. We could look at adjusting this area to include US 62 from Rockwell to NE 10<sup>th</sup> if it won't put us over the 300,000 gpd limit.
